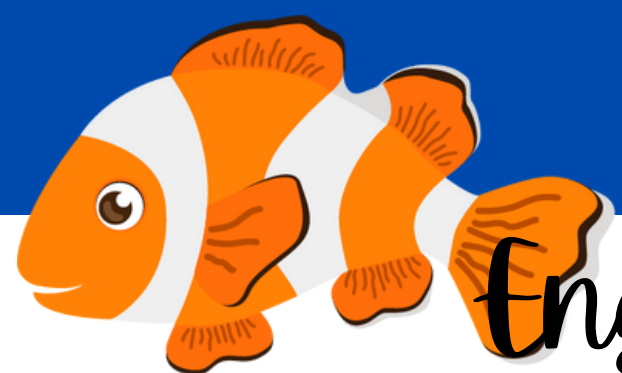


WHAT YOUR CHILD IS LEARNING AT CRANBROOK



Year 1. Term 4



English

This term, students will be developing their reading and viewing skills by exploring a variety of stories and informative texts. They'll learn to think about what they read and watch, make connections to their own experiences, and understand how characters, settings, and events are presented.

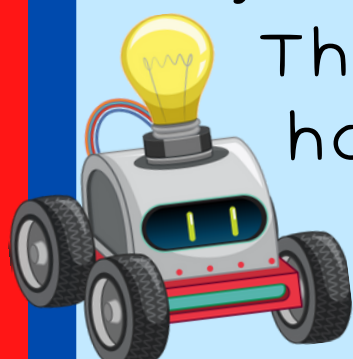
They'll also begin to recognise how different types of texts are structured, and how language and visuals work together to communicate ideas.



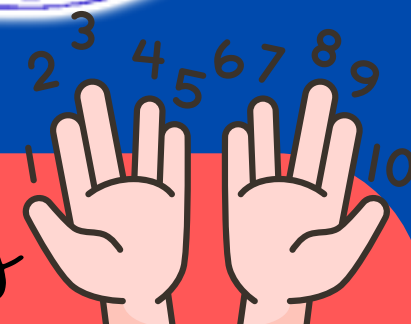
Science

Students will explore sources of light and sound. They will manipulate materials to observe how light and sound are produced, and how changes can be made to light and sound effects. Students will make a sound instrument and explore changes they can make to their instrument.

They will make observations of how these changes affect the sound.



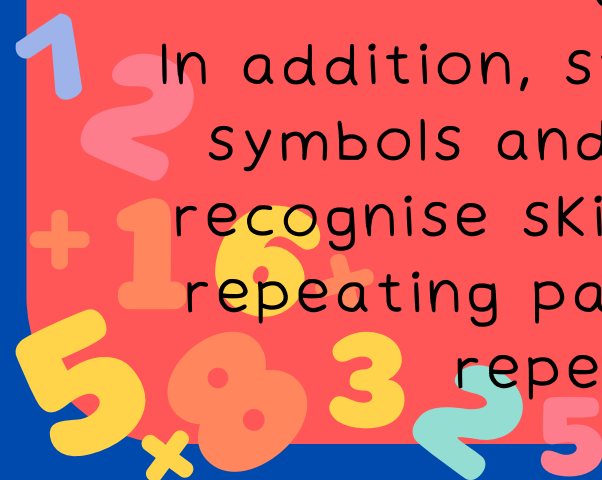
Mathematics



This term in maths, students will explore how numbers can be broken into parts in different ways. They'll learn how two-digit numbers can be split into tens and ones to help build their understanding of place value.

They'll also practise grouping objects into equal sets and skip counting by 2s, 5s, and 10s, working with numbers up to at least 120.

In addition, students will use numbers, symbols and objects to create and recognise skip counting patterns and repeating patterns, identifying what repeats in each one.



HASS



Students will continue to explore the different landscapes looking at the natural, managed and constructed features. Students will identify how different people use the different places. They will also look at how we can care for different places to make sure they can be enjoyed by others.



What Can I Do To Help My Child?

Practice skip counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

Practise dividing different objects in the house Explore various objects around the home that make light and sound. Read every night and practice their tricky words with them.

Read narratives and discuss the character, settings and events.

Music & Visual Art



In Term 4, Year 1 students are continuing their understanding of Drama and Music. In Drama, Year 1 will participate in process drama in a shop setting, creating their own scene. In Music, Year 1 students will perform music influenced by the jungle.



Physical Education



In term 4 for PE the students will be developing their long rope skipping skills and discussing how their heart reacts to participating in skipping sequences.
