TERM 4, 2025



In Maths this term students will order and represent natural numbers beyond 10 000. They will extend and use single-digit addition and related subtraction facts and apply additive strategies to model and solve problems involving two- and three-digit numbers. They will make estimates and determine the reasonableness of financial and other calculations. Students will also find unknown values in number sentences involving addition and subtraction. Finally, they will create algorithms to investigate numbers and explore simple patterns.



Year 3 students in Term 43 will enjoy working in the Media and Music strands of The Arts. In Media students will use 'Stop Motion Pro' to create an animation. In Music students will perform an Australian song on ukulele.

SCIENCE

This term students will conduct investigations to explore how liquids and solids change their states when heat is added.





ENGLISH

In English this term, students will read, view and answer questions about the imaginative text Kumiko and the Dragon. They will also create their own narrative text about overcoming a fear.

HASS

Students will represent data about places and compare places; explain the importance of making decisions democratically and the role of rules in the community; devise an action in response to an issue.



HEALTH & PE

In term 4 for PE the students will be developing their juggling and balancing skills using a variety of sports equipment.
