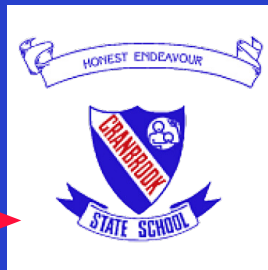




In Term 4 Year 4 are learning



MATHS

Students will draw on proficiency with addition and multiplication facts to add and subtract, multiply and divide numbers efficiently. They will use algorithms to generate sets of numbers, recognising and describing any patterns that emerge.

Students will draw on reasoning skills to analyse, categorise and order chance events and identify independent and dependent events. They will investigate variability by conducting repeated chance experiments, observing results.

ENGLISH

Through a novel study, students identify characteristic stages of narrative texts, for example, orientation, complication and resolution.

Students engage in shared and independent writing to create written responses about what they have read, using paragraphs to organise and link ideas, and language features including complex sentences, topic-specific vocabulary and literary devices. Students will create a written narrative story that involves an adventure.

SCIENCE

Students use games to investigate and demonstrate the direction of forces and the effect of contact and non-contact forces on objects. They identify how science knowledge of forces helps people understand the effects of their actions.



In Term 4 Year 4 are learning



HASS

Students will explore the concept of 'place' with a focus on Africa and South America. They will describe the relative location of places at a national scale. Students will identify how places are characterised by their environments and describe the characteristics of places, including the types of natural vegetation and native animals.

TECHNOLOGIES

Students investigate food and fibre production and food technologies used in modern and traditional societies. They design and make a lunch item that includes modern and traditional technologies.

HEALTH

Students interpret health messages and discuss the influences on healthy choices. They use decision-making skills to select strategies that help them stay healthy and active.

The ARTS

In Term 4, Year 4 respond to and create a dance that tells a story.

PE

In term 4 students will be developing their juggling and balancing skills using a variety of sports equipment.
