The Arts

Students will be exploring printmaking which is an artistic process that involves creating images by transferring ink from a matrix onto another surface such as paper or fabric.

MATHS


In Maths this term students will:

- Use place value to write and order decimals greater than one
- Create and use algorithms to identify and explain patterns with factors and multiples
- Conduct repeated chance experiments
- Use factors and multiples to solve calculations
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division

ENGLISH

Students will read, view and comprehend a chapter from the fantasy text 'The Callers'.

They will write a fantasy imaginative text and use Canva to create a book cover to suit their text. Students will use text structure and language features to engage their audience.



HASS

Students will identify the importance of values and processes to Australia's democracy. They will work collaboratively to generate different responses to issues. Students will also describe factors that influence consumer's choices and strategies that can be used to inform these choices. They will recognise that choices need to be made when allocating resources.

SCIENCE

Students will be looking at states of matter through a fantasy lense, where their substances will be potions.

Students will be classifying substances as solids, liquids and gases according to their properties and behaviours. They will be identifying patterns in data to classify a mystery substance.



In PE, students will be developing their passing (shoulder and push pass), kicking (punt kick) and catching skills (taking a mark) in game situations. They will also develop their ability to use space, timing and offensive and defensive strategies to enhance participation in games.

In Health, students will be learning how outside influences effect emotions/behaviours in different situations and strategies to use when transitioning to year 6 leaders.
