
Term 4 Jear 6 are Jearning




ENGLISH

This term, Year 6 students are reading
The Wild Robot by Peter Brown. A story
about friendship, belonging and
survival. They'll explore how authors
use language and structure to create
meaning and mood, then apply these
techniques to write their own science
fiction story.

For assessment, students will complete a reading comprehension task and a creative narrative inspired by the novel.





SCIENCE

This term, students are learning to think and write like scientists by conducting an investigation into microorganisms and hygiene. They will plan and carry out experiments such as testing the best way to prevent the spread of germs or exploring the ideal conditions for

Students will follow the scientific report format, including a title, question, prediction, materials, procedure, results and conclusion. They'll observe changes, record data and use scientific reasoning to explain what happened and why, linking their findings to real-world

microorganism growth.

MATHS

In Mathematics, Year 6 students are building their understanding of number, algebra and probability. They will solve real-world problems involving fractions, decimals and percentages, and use rules and algorithms to create and extend number patterns. In probability, students will describe and compare the likelihood of events and explore how results can change over many trials through chance experiments and simulations.

HASS

This term, Year 6 students are exploring how societies have responded to pandemics throughout history. Through the unit "How Will I Survive the Next Pandemic?", students will investigate the causes and impacts and compare how people in the past and present have managed disease outbreaks.

They will examine different perspectives and government responses to pandemics and consider the social and economic effects on communities and businesses.



ARTS

Year 6 students will respond to and perform music from around the world to determine how rhythm, pitch, dynamics, expression, tempo and form vary from country to country. In Dance in Term 4, Year 6 learn and perform their upcoming graduation dances.



HPE

In term 4 for PE the students will be developing their passing (shoulder and push pass), kicking (punt kick), and catching skills (taking a mark) in game situations. They will also develop their ability to use space, timing and offensive and defensive strategies to enhance participation in games.

In Health students will be learning how outside influences effect emotions/behaviours in different situations and strategies to use when transitioning to highschool.

TECHNOLOGY

This term, Year 6 students are learning how data and digital systems shape our world. They will explore how information systems meet community needs and learn to collect, analyse and present data using digital tools such as spreadsheets.

Students will design and create an interactive spreadsheet, applying problem-solving skills to automate and present information effectively. They will also learn about ethical and safe data practices, including protecting information and using technology responsibly.
